**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 POLICE REGULATIONS OF  
THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, COUNTY OF ESSEX  
RELATING TO  
DRUNK AND DISORDERLY PERSONS**

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Fairfield that it is necessary to amend Chapter 3 Police Regulations – Drunk and Disorderly Persons.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Fairfield, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The following shall be an amendment to the Municipal Code of the Township of Fairfield, relating to Police Regulations:

**Chapter 3. Police Regulations**

**Section 3-14.5 Drunk and Disorderly Persons.**

Section 3-14.5 shall be eliminated in its entirety.

The section shall remain the same except that the remaining sections will have to be renumbered as shown below. The contents of the renumbered Section 3-14.5 through Section 3-14.17 will not be changed.

**Section 3-14.5 Disorderly Persons.**

**Section 3-14.6 Gambling.**

**Section 3-14.7 Destruction of Property.**

**Section 3-14.8 Interfering with Schools.**

**Section 3-14.9 Interfering with Official Bodies and Officials.**

**Section 3-14.10 Depositing Substances on Streets; Missiles.**

**Section 3-14.11 Interfering with Other Persons.**

**Section 3-14.12 Weapons.**

**Section 3-14.13 Altercations; Riots; Disorderly Assemblages.**

**Section 3-14.14 Garbage, Sewage and Waste Matter.**

**Section 3-14.15 Interfering with Passage to or Over Public Thoroughfares.**

**Section 3-14.16 Certain Acts Prohibited.**


**Section 3-14-17 Definitions.**

This Ordinance amendment shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.

2. All Ordinances of the Township of Fairfield which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
