**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 TRAFFIC OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, COUNTY OF ESSEX
RELATING TO
REGULATION FOR THE MOVEMENT AND THE PARKING OF
TRAFFIC ON ALL OTHER PRIVATE PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Fairfield that it is necessary to amend Chapter 7 Traffic, Section 7-37.3 Regulation for the Movement and the Parking of Traffic on All Other Private Property.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Fairfield, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The following shall be an amendment to the Municipal Code of the Township of Fairfield, relating to Traffic:

Chapter 7. Traffic

Section 7-37.3 Regulation for the Movement and the Parking of Traffic on All Other Private Property.

Add a new section d. and the existing section d. shall become an amended e.


d. *Adali Stevenson School*. The provisions of Subtitle 1 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey be and are hereby made applicable to the private roadways and parking areas of the above-referenced property located within the Township. Said statutes and the regulations which follow shall be enforceable upon this property. The regulation which will be enforceable upon this property is the addition of a stop sign at the right-of-way at the end of Knoll Road prior to entering the school property.

~~d-~~ e. The following regulations shall be enforceable as to the properties referenced in paragraphs a., b., c., **and d.**

The rest of this section shall remain the same.


This Ordinance amendment shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.

2. All Ordinances of the Township of Fairfield which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
