

**TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD
ORDINANCE #2010-03**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND
SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, COUNTY OF ESSEX
RELATING TO SEWER RATE ADJUSTMENT**

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Fairfield that it is necessary to amend the sewer rate in order to provide for the cost of operating the Township's sewer utility.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following shall be an amendment to the Municipal Code of the Township of Fairfield, relating to Sewer:

Chapter 17. Sewer

Section 17-5.1 Fees and Charges.


- a. There is hereby established the following schedule of public sewer charges for the connection, inspection and use of the public sewer system:

RESIDENTIAL	Fee
Connection charge	\$1,100.00
Sewer connection inspection	30.00
Sewer use charge per quarter	123.00 (\$130.00)


NON- FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP	Fee
Connection charge	\$1,100.00
Sewer connection inspection	30.00
Sewer use charge per quarter	162.00 (\$170.00)

INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL	Fee
Connection charge	\$1,100.00
Sewer connection inspection	30.00
Sewer use charge, minimum charge, per quarter	123.00 (\$130.00)

1. The minimum charge per quarter shall be based upon a water usage of fifteen thousand (15,000) gallons per quarter, with an additional charge of ~~thirteen dollars and zero cents (\$13.00)~~ **thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75)** per thousand (1,000) gallons for use in excess of fifteen thousand (15,000) gallons per quarter. The charge for each quarter, however, shall be based upon the water usage for the first quarter of that particular year as indicated by the water meter reading; unless, in the opinion of the Municipal Engineer, water usage from another quarter or portion of quarter provides a better basis for setting the sewer use charge for the year in question.
2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
3. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause of provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
