

**TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD
ORDINANCE #2012-16**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7-13
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD
REGARDING PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON
CERTAIN STREETS**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Governing Body of the Township of Fairfield request changes be made to the Ordinance regarding prohibiting parking on the northwest side of Fairfield Court; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that Fairfield Court is narrow; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that there is insufficient width on this roadway for emergency vehicles when both sides of the street are utilized by parked cars; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that public safety will be advanced by restricting the parking on the right (northwest) side of Fairfield Court; and

WHEREAS, at the request of the Governing Body, Chapter 7-13 shall be amended to reflect that parking is prohibited on the northwest side of Fairfield Court; and


WHEREAS, based upon the foregoing, the Governing Body of the Township of Fairfield has found it necessary to amend the Ordinance and finds these changes to be in the best interest of Fairfield Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND
COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE
OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:**


1. Chapter 7-13 shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows: Add the following street to the chart in between Fairfield Avenue and Gardner Road.

<i>Name of Street</i>	<i>Side</i>	<i>Location</i>
Fairfield Avenue	North	Entire length
Fairfield Court	Northwest	Beginning from its point of intersection with Fairfield Road 630 feet SouthEast
Gardner Road	North	Beginning from its point of intersection with Route 46 to a point formed by the intersection of the northerly side of Gardner Road and the extension of the property line separating Lot 1 and Lot 2 in Block 5702 as shown on the Official Maps of the Borough of Fairfield

2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
3. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause of provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
