AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD
ADDING A STOP SIGN

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the Township of Fairfield has determined that a stop sign needs to be installed for traffic safety reasons on the shared private driveway of property known as Block 2101, Lot 8.02 – the Dunkin Donut site. This driveway should be placed at the bend of the driveway before exiting out onto Little Falls Road; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 7 Section 7.19 needs to be amended to provide for that stop sign by adding a new Section a. *Private Driveways*; and

WHEREAS, based upon the foregoing, the Governing Body of the Township of Fairfield agrees that amending the Ordinance to include this stop sign is in the best interest of Fairfield Township.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

- Chapter 7 Traffic – Section 7.19 Through Streets, **new section a. to be added entitled Private Driveways**. The following stop sign shall be added to the designated list of stop signs.

a. Private Driveways

Stop sign location

- 1. Property known as Block 2101, Lot 8.02**

At the bend of the shared private driveway prior to exiting onto Little Falls Road

- All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
- This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication, in accordance with law.
