

**TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD
ORDINANCE #2014-10**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII OF THE
TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD,
ENTITLED "TRAFFIC", SO AS TO ADD STOP SIGNS AT
DESIGNATED INTERSECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the Township of Fairfield requests changes be made to Chapter VII, Sections 7.20 and 7.21 of the Township Code for the purpose of adding stop signs at stop intersections that presently do not have any stop signs; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Fairfield has found it necessary to amend the Township Code as requested by the Police Department to include a list of new intersections requiring stop signs and finds the changes to be in the interest of public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Fairfield, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter VII, Section 7.20, entitled "Traffic – Stop Intersections," is hereby amended to add the following stop sign at the designated intersection:

<i>Intersection</i>	<i>Stop sign on</i>
Crestwood Avenue West and Jorgenson Lane	Crestwood Avenue West

SECTION 2. Chapter VII, Section 7.21, entitled "Traffic – Multi-Way Stops," is hereby amended as follows:

§ 7.21 Multi-Way Stops.

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the following intersections are hereby designated as Multi-Way Stops.

a. Three-Way Stops.

...

3. A stop sign on Henning Drive approaching Bodkin Road and a stop sign on Bodkin Road entering Henning Drive. A stop sign on Henning Drive approaching Bodkin Road from the opposite direction.


4. A stop sign on Henning Drive approaching Cheri Lane and a stop sign on Cheri Lane entering Henning Drive. A stop sign on Henning Drive approaching Cheri Lane from the opposite direction.
- b. Four-Way Stops. The following described intersections are hereby designated as four-way stop intersections. Stop signs shall be installed on the right-hand side of each approach thereto:

<i>Intersection</i>	<i>Stop signs on</i>
Bodkin Road and Campbell Road	Bodkin Road and Campbell Road
Henning Drive and Campbell Road	Henning Drive and Campbell Road


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
