

**TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD
ORDINANCE #2017-01**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18-2.4 OF THE
TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD
REGARDING WATER SERVICE CHARGES**

WHEREAS, the Passaic Valley Water Commission adopted a five-year comprehensive operating and capital plan in 2009, underwent extensive budget reviews for years since and updated the plan for 2014-2018, and commissioned a Cost of Service Allocation Study to ensure that rates are equitable while meeting the Passaic Valley Water Commission's legal and fiduciary responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2017, the wholesale water rates will increase from \$2,508.58 per MGD to \$2,634.01 per MGD; and

WHEREAS, based upon the foregoing, the Governing Body of the Township of Fairfield has found it necessary to increase its rate for water service charges to its residents, effective January 1, 2017, in order to offset increases from the Passaic Valley Water Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Fairfield, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 18-2.4, entitled "Water Service Charges," of the Township Code of the Township of Fairfield is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 18-2.4. Water Service Charges.

- a. The quarterly charges for water consumed at the building or buildings on the premises served, as measured by the water meter, shall be as follows:
 1. Zero (0) to fifteen thousand (15,000) gallons: ~~fifty six dollars (\$56.00) for 2016; fifty-nine dollars (\$59.00) for 2017.~~
 2. Above 15 thousand (15,000) gallons: ~~four dollars and seventy five cents (\$4.75) for 2016~~ five dollars (\$5.00) for 2017 for every additional one thousand (1,000) gallons.
- b. Billings for water consumed at each building shall be determined by the Water Department.
- c. The filing of residential swimming pools located within approximately three hundred (300) feet of an available water hydrant shall be performed by the Municipal Water Department at a flat fee to the owner or occupant in the amount of ~~one hundred and ninety five (\$195.00) dollars~~ two hundred and five dollars (\$205.00) payable in advance.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause of provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law, and the rate changes shall take effect as of January 1, 2017.


