

**TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD
ORDINANCE #2017-18**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII, ARTICLE 21, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, ENTITLED “MULTI-WAY STOPS”, SO AS TO ADD THREE-WAY STOP SIGNS AT DESIGNATED INTERSECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the Township of Fairfield requests changes be made to Chapter VII, Article 21 of the Township Code for the purpose of adding three-way stop signs at stop intersections that presently do not have any stop signs; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Fairfield has found it necessary to amend the Township Code as requested by the Police Department to include a list of new intersections requiring stop signs and finds the changes to be in the interest of public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Fairfield, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter VII, Article 21, entitled “Multi-Way Stops,” is hereby amended to add the following stop signs at the designated intersections:

7-21 MULTI-WAY STOPS.

The following intersections are hereby designated as Multi-Way Stops.

a. Three-Way Stops.

5. A stop sign on each end of Big Piece Road where it meets Sylvan Road, and a stop sign on Sylvan Road entering Big Piece Road.
6. A stop sign on each end of Big Piece Road where it meets Winfield Court, and a stop sign on Winfield Court entering Big Piece Road.
7. A stop sign on each end of Big Piece Road where it meets Dell Court, and a stop sign on Dell Court entering Big Piece Road.
8. A stop sign on each end of Big Piece Road where it meets Kennedy Drive, and a stop sign on Kennedy Drive entering Big Piece Road.


9. A stop sign on each end of Kennedy Drive where it meets Holly Drive, and a stop sign on Holly Drive entering Kennedy Drive.

10. A stop sign on each end of Esposito Drive where it meets Crestwood Drive, and a stop sign on Crestwood Drive entering Esposito Drive.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.


