### **MANDATORY CONCUSSION TESTING**

The Fairfield Recreation Department continues to have the safety of our children in mind with the implementation of mandatory concussion testing for all children entering 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grades registered in our youth athletic programs, effective immediately. ***Failure to comply with this testing will result in your child not being allowed to participate in any recreation-sponsored athletics.***

Testing will be conducted using ImPACT baseline screening, through Barnabas Health Ambulatory Care Center. If an incident occurs, a test will be conducted and compared to this baseline screening.

Screening will be offered three times a year at Stevenson School computer lab. Once registered in a program, parents will be notified with their assigned testing time; please be prompt. ***Due to limited computer availability, ASSIGNED TIMES MUST BE ADHERED TO.*** If you are unable to make your assigned date and time slot, please report for testing as designated for walk-ins. Schedules will be strictly followed.

Testing takes approximately 20 minutes; parents are welcomed to stay in the designated sitting area until testing is completed.
